LESSON PLAN (PART 3)

Materials Needed:

1. Pencils
2. Highlighters
3. Graph Paper
4. Light boards (or tape printouts with graph paper on top to windows with access to sunlight)
5. Thin black Sharpies
6. **Student Resource Printouts**

Teacher Preparation:

1. Post the driving question somewhere in the classroom where students can reference it throughout the project.
2. Print the **Ancient Civilization Structures** (each on a separate page) from the Student Resources page.
3. Print the **Area of Ancient Composite Structures** handout from the Student Resources page for each member of each group.
4. Print a formative rubric for each member of each group for the **Area of Ancient Composite Structures** handout.
5. Provide enough graph paper for each group.
 - a. This ensures they have ample graph paper for possible mistakes.
6. Make sure every group member has a pencil, graph paper, thin Sharpies, and erasers.
